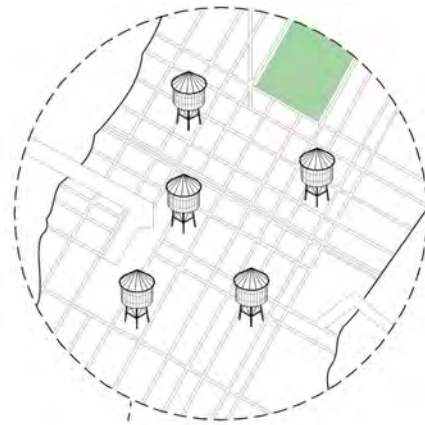


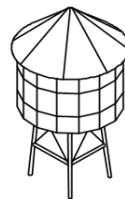
# Cedar — Natural

## Skyline Collection



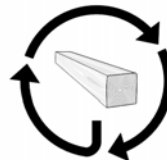
### Product Information

Refacing our vintage Cedar water tower staves gives them a fresh surface and a modern look. Pale, blonde tones, darkened pin knots, and a dense, flowing grain are revealed from beneath the patina. Mottled gray areas of oxidation result from contact with water and offer indications of its past life.

Historic material re-use and local manufacturing support a circular economy and reduces a building project's carbon footprint.



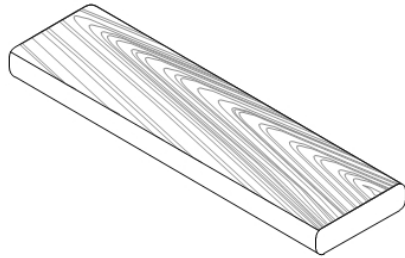

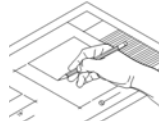


EASED 4 EDGES
